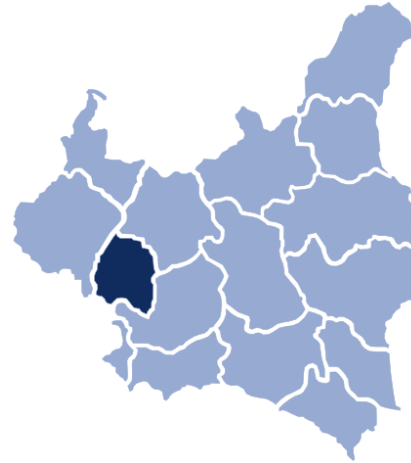
- 672 185 citizens (XII 2020)

History

- Łęczyca, Sieradz, Piotrków - the most important historical towns.
- After II Partition of Poland - Łódź Province under Russian and Prussian occupation.
- 1919 - Łódź becomes the province
- September 1939 - bloody battle of Bzura
- After II WW Łódź changes its area.
- Łódź - the centre of textile industry

Multicultural Łódź

The development of Łódź in 19th century is due to four nations: not only Polish people but also those who came to the city: Germans, Jews and Russians. Living together in harmony they built huge factories, beautiful tenement houses, sacred places of different religions, they also developed cultural and scientific life. All those multicultural actions of four nations are still visible in Lodz architecture and local cuisine as well as in the annual Festival Lodz of Four Cultures.

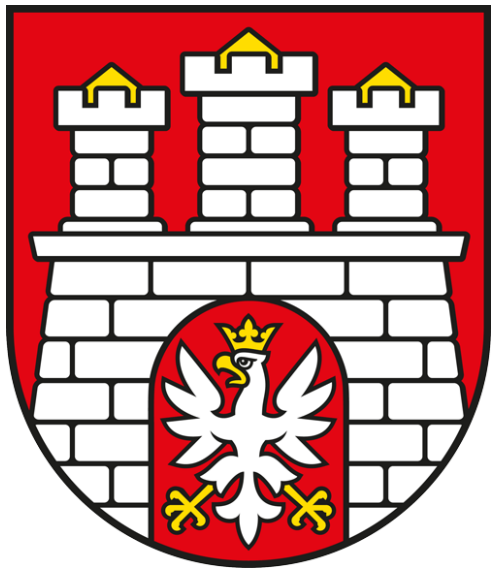
Zgierz from bird's eye view

History of Zgierz

- One of the oldest cities in the Łódź Province
- Zgierz got city rights before 1288
- 30.03.1821 - conclusion of the Zgierz Agreement
- Zgierz was bombed at the beginning of II World War
- 20.03.1942 - public execution of 100 Poles
- 17.01.1945 - liberation of the city
- After the war Zgierz became industrial town

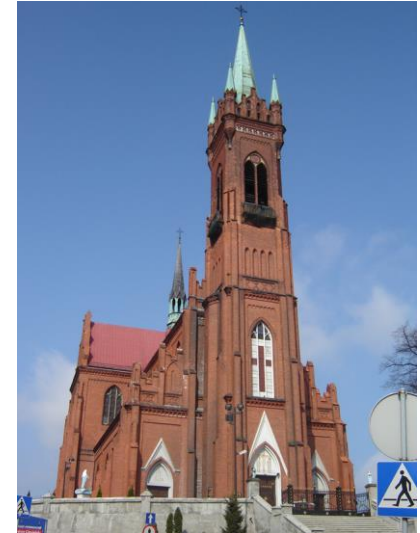

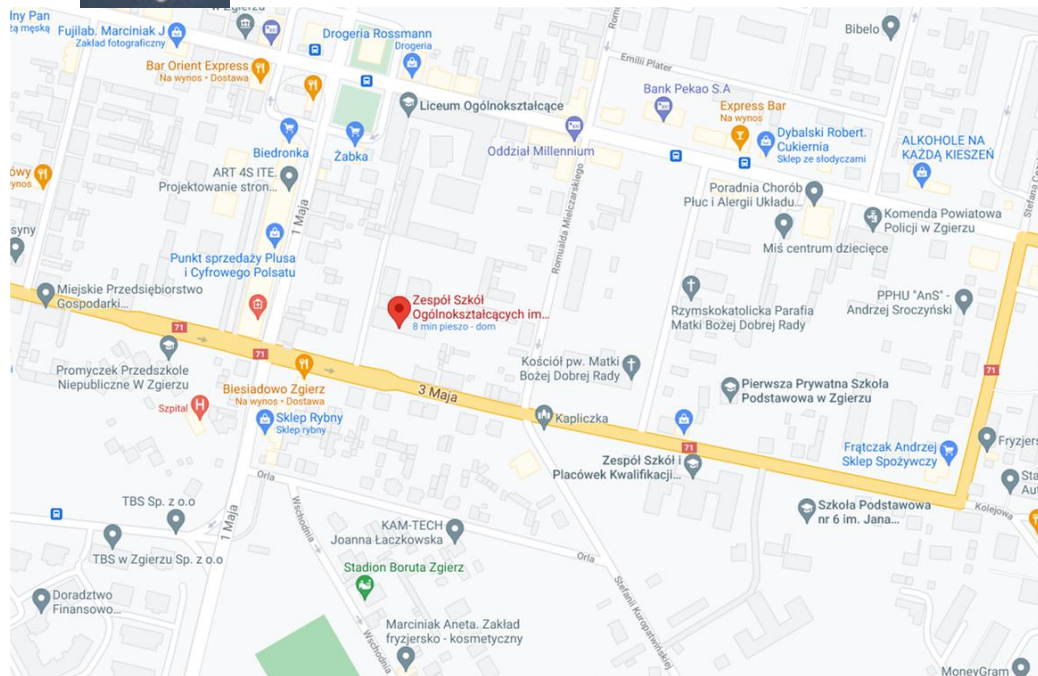

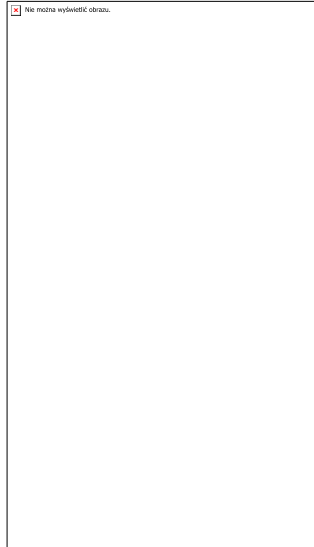

History



Female students in postwar period

1898 - establishment of the 7th grade male School of Economics

September 1939 - most of the school materials were burned by the Germans and Polish children were forbidden to study; secret teaching starts.

March 1945 - resumption of education at school with not enough materials.

1950 - the first reunion of graduates, which continues to this day.

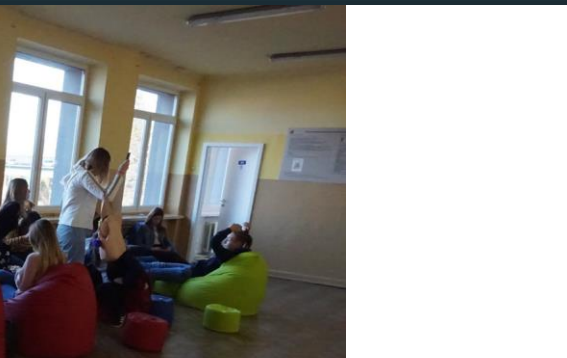


The School also hosts numerous events such as:
